QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Experience as bus driver preferred
2. Knowledge of traffic and school bus regulations
3. Possession of school bus driver's license
4. Good physical condition
5. Ability to follow oral and written directions
6. Ability to work with and supervise children

REPORTS TO: Administrator as assigned

JOB GOAL: To transport students to and from school and on extracurricular activities in safe and efficient manner

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Drives school bus on assigned route to carry pupils to and from school and on extracurricular trips
2. Cleans and washes buses
3. Works in shop performing odd jobs as necessary in transportation department
4. Performs other related duties as assigned

SALARY: Prorated salary based on hours worked. Eight (8) hour equivalent:
\$2,159 - \$2,625 per month

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with the District's "Improvement of Professional Services" handbook, Board Policies and Procedures and consistent with collective bargaining agreements when applicable

NEW PROBATIONARY EMPLOYEES AND PERMANENT EMPLOYEES WHO BECOME PROBATIONARY UPON RECLASSIFICATION:

A new employee, or a permanent employee who is changed to a new classification, shall serve a probationary period, which shall not exceed one (1) year of duty time exclusive of leaves of absences or other absences. During this probationary period the employee must meet the required standards of performance to be recommended for permanent status in the classification. A probationary classified service employee may be terminated from the probationary classification at any time without cause, without right of appeal or hearing before the Board of Education. Pursuant to Education Code section 45113, a permanent employee who accepts a promotion and fails to complete the probationary period for that promotional position, shall be employed in the classification from which he or she was promoted.

MINIMUM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

The documents listed below must be on file in Personnel Services. Applications will be taken until positions are filled.

1. Completed employment application (Application form with revised date of 7/06 or later)
2. California School Bus Driver Certificate
3. Current Medical certificate
4. Current H-6 DMV printout
5. Current TO-1 card

Copies of required certificates, transcripts or diplomas may be submitted with application. District may require that originals be presented for verification prior to employment. Please check with Personnel Services regarding acceptable certificates. For positions requiring college course work official transcripts will be required upon employment.

It is the applicant's responsibility to meet all application requirements and supply copies of all required documents. A separate set of paperwork is required for each application submitted. All application materials submitted become the property of Bakersfield City School District.

The Bakersfield City School District wishes to thank all applicants for their interest in this position. Positions may be readvertised or application deadlines extended at the discretion of the District. Unless otherwise notified by the District, applications received in response to this bulletin will be considered for available District positions in this classification during the current school year. Those meeting minimum qualifications, including passage of required tests, will remain active during this time. Applicants will not be individually notified of their application status.
