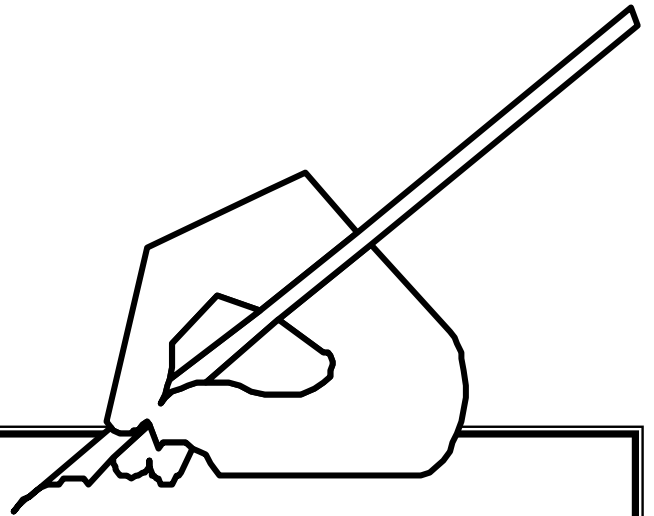
## Narrative Something Special
