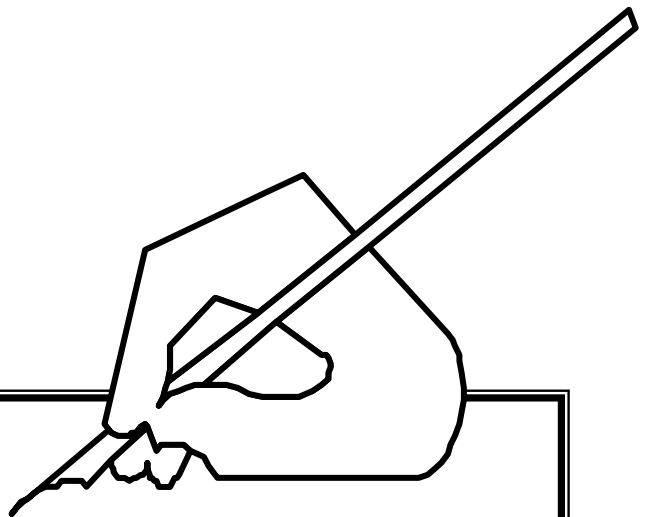
Writing a Personal Experience
