Cancer Medical Reimbursement

Pays for medical expenses not fully reimbursed by a primary health carrier (up to 30%), including deductible. Other major diseases also covered, such as: polio, multiple sclerosis, etc. This policy is a must for anyone with Blue Cross/Blue Shield type 80/20 or 70/30 medical insurance. Annual premium is \$46-individual or \$52-family.

Accidental Death (AD&D) Insurance

Rates much lower than credit card or airline offerings.
