RE: TULARE COUNTY A.C.S.A. CHARTER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Tulare County Charter of the Association of California School Administrators provides an opportunity for graduating seniors, who have a parent or guardian with a current Tulare County Charter of A.C.S.A. membership, to apply for Charter scholarships. It is our hope that you would review the scholarship information and complete the application.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. The applicant must be graduating this school year.
2. The parent or legal guardian must have a current membership with the Tulare County Charter of A.C.S.A.
3. The applicant must have maintained a G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher for the seven semesters prior to the application deadline
4. Transcript -Sealed Envelope - Courses in progress (Spring Semester).
5. The applicant must arrange for three letters of recommendation, in sealed envelopes, from the following:
 - A. Applicant's high school counselor
 - B. A high school teacher
 - C. An advisor of school, community, or church group.
6. **The application along with the three recommendations must be submitted to the scholarship committee chairperson by Friday, March 25, 2011, no later than 4:00 p.m. Please deliver to Tulare City School District Office, 600 N. Cherry, Tulare, CA, 93274, Attention: Clare Gist (559-685-7200).**

The scholarship committee will review the applications and recommendations. Committee decisions will be based on academic scholarship, citizenship, leadership, and contributions to the school and community. The Charter committee will award scholarships of a minimum of \$200.00.

The applications of the top applicants, based on the information provided to the committee, will be submitted to the Region XI A.C.S.A. Scholarship Committee. The Region committee will also be awarding scholarships to the top candidates from the Charter.

The scholarships from the Charter and the Region are paid upon the recipient's entrance to college. The scholarship winners must provide the A.C.S.A. scholarship committee with verification of college enrollment.

7. Application and recommendations submitted by **Friday, March 25, 2011 no later than 4:00 p.m., to Tulare City School District Office, 600 N. Cherry, Tulare, CA, 93274, attention: Clare Gist.**
8. Notification of award by, **April 15, 2011**

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION: The applicant will be considered using the following:

1. Grade point average and courses completed.
2. In-school and out-of-school participation and leadership.
3. Plans for college and future career.
