1. Alliteration	a. Identifying words that end with the same sound
2. Phoneme	b. The smallest unit of sounds that combine to form words and syllables
3. Rhyme	c. The relation between letters and sounds in written words
4. Phonemic awareness	d. Identifying words that begin with the same sound
5. On-set	e. The whole spectrum from primitive awareness of speech sounds to phonemic awareness
6. Phonological awareness	f. The ability to recognize spoken words as a sequence of sounds
7. Rime	g. The first vowel in a word and all the sounds that come after it. Examples: /at/ in hat /ank/ in tank
8. Phonics	h. All the sounds of a word that come before the first vowel. Examples: /b/ before /ank/ /c/ before /at/
