



## NoHo CEL Release 4.16 patch 1

NoHo CEL release 4.16 patch 1 contains the following:

### FAMILY INFO

- 1) **Family Form-** The following changes were made:
  - a. **Search Families Form** (*accessed by clicking the binoculars next to the Family ID field*)- In version 4.16, users may get an error when running a family search that returns more than 500 records. Due to an Internet Explorer limitation, the family search form is now limited to displaying a maximum of 500 records. If a user runs a search that returns more than 500 records, only the first 500 will be displayed and the user will get a message telling them that only the first 500 records are displayed and advising them to refine their search criteria. **(Reported by: Bananas- Alameda County)**
  - b. **Family Application Status Form-** In 4.16, when the new “Require Employment Income” option was enabled, there were cases where records were incorrectly marked as Incomplete. This only occurred when the new option was enabled. This has been resolved. **(Reported by: North Coast Opportunities- Lake/Mendocino County)**
  
- 2) **Children Form-** The following changes were made:
  - a. **Search Children Form** (*accessed by clicking the binoculars next to the Child ID field*)- In version 4.16, users may get an error when running a child search that returns more than 500 records. Due to an Internet Explorer limitation, the child search form is now limited to displaying a maximum of 500 records. If a user runs a search that returns more than 500 records, only the first 500 will be displayed and the user will get a message telling them that only the first 500 records are displayed and advising them to refine their search criteria. **(DGI/NoHo Software)**
  - b. **Search Children Form** (*accessed by clicking the binoculars next to the Child ID field*)- In version 4.16, there were cases where incorrect parent names were displayed for the children in the results list. This has been resolved. Note: This did not affect family or child data, it only affected the display of the records in the list. **(Reported by: Bananas- Alameda County)**
  
- 3) **Child Form-** The following changes were made:
  - a. When a child is added to the CEL database, a child status entry will be added automatically to the Child Status Tab. The status note will include the date and initial enrollment status of the child. **(DGI/NoHo Software)**



- b. When a child's Continuity of Care enrollment status has expired and the child's enrollment status is automatically reset to Waiting, a child status entry will be added automatically to the Child Status Tab. The status note will include the date of the expiration. **(DGI/NoHo Software)**
- c. When a child's Intake enrollment status has expired and the child's enrollment status is automatically reset, a child status entry will be added automatically to the Child Status Tab. The status note will include the date of the expiration. **(DGI/NoHo Software)**

## **ELIGIBILITY SEARCH**

- 1) In 4.16, when the new "Require Employment Income" option was enabled, there were cases where records were being excluded from the eligibility search because they were incorrectly marked as Incomplete. This only occurred when the new option was enabled. This has been resolved. **(Reported by: North Coast Opportunities- Lake/Mendocino County)**

**NoHo software releases are NOT cumulative and require the download and installation of all SQL scripts from all previous patches and releases in order to run successfully.** The SQL scripts for each patch and/or release are available in zipped files from our website. All SQL scripts must be run in order. After running each set of SQL scripts, please review the cappsscr.log file in the script directory to ensure that the scripts ran successfully. If you are unsure whether there are any problems with the scripts, please contact DGI.
