<i>Type of services provided?</i>	The qualified patient will receive an extensive vision exam and lenses, if needed (the frame is not included). Frames are usually donated by the eye doctor and the selection could be limited.	
<i>Who qualifies?</i>	At least one adult in the household must be employed. The family should be of low income. The individual requesting the exam cannot be insured or had a vision exam within the last two years.
