Responsibilities of the Coaches

Set a positive example for players and spectators at all times.

Accept your responsibility as a coach by always showing respect for your athletes and your sport.

Enforce penalties for your participants who do not abide by sportsmanship standards.

Show respect for the officials' judgment and their interpretation of the rules.

Responsibilities of the Participants (Athletes)

Use appropriate language.

Exercise self-control at all times.

Respect the officials' judgment and interpretation of the rules.

Accept the responsibility and privilege of representing your school by acting in a manner that will create a positive attitude.

Each school cleans their respective areas.

Responsibilities of the Spectators

Respect decisions made by the officials.

Respect the judgment and strategy of the coach and the efforts made by players.

Avoid criticizing players, coaches, and officials after the activity.
