The Computer Using Educator (CUE) Site Leader of the Year Award recognizes a school site principal or assistant principal (or equivalent) who has made a noteworthy contribution to promoting educational technology within his/her school. Recipients must demonstrate the following:

- Strong support for the belief that all students will excel academically
- Exceptional leadership in finding ways that technology benefits teaching and learning
- Building staff morale or the learning environment
- A commitment to educational quality and student achievement
- A commitment to professional growth
- Creativity and innovation in dealing with issues and problems facing public education.

Nominations for this category can be submitted by CUE members (all categories), CUE affiliates, SIGs, CUE Committees, the Board of Directors, and staff members.

# *Site Leader of the Year Award*

## **Criteria for Selection**

Nominees are evaluated according to the degree to which he or she meets some or all of the following criteria. Note: Technology is assumed to mean more than just computers.

1. The nominee's work reflects the mission and purpose of CUE.\*
2. The nominee's work can be used as a model for promoting the use of educational technology to enhance student achievement.
3. The nominee is a K-12 site level principal or assistant principal (or equivalent).
4. The nominee's work has had a significant positive impact on technology use in education: locally, regionally and/or statewide.
5. The nominee has made efforts to involve the community to facilitate partnerships with business and/or legislators to advance the use of technology in education.
6. The nominee works above and beyond to genuinely improve the quality of education.
7. The nominee has integrated deliberate planning in an effort to improve education through the use of technology.
8. The quality of education and/or work experience has been significantly advanced in the nominee's workplace as a result of the nominee's efforts.
9. The nominee has contributed to the profession by presenting at professional conferences, seminars and/or workshops or publishing articles in print or through electronic media.
10. The nominee will represent CUE well in all forums.
