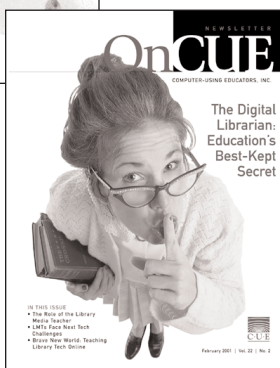
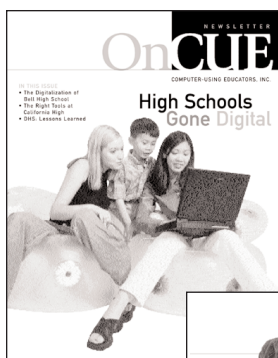

Style Notes

Our focus audience is comprised of educators and others (primarily members of Computer-Using Educators) interested in promoting the effective use of technology in the curriculum. *OnCUE* follows AP style, uses active, direct voice; encourages use of subheads throughout stories, and provides names, titles and affiliations for those cited.

Word Count

Features	1200-1800 words
News	100-250
Calendar	Include name, sponsor of event, site and contact info.

Deadlines

Issues are planned three months in advanced and writers are given one month to complete assignment. There is a two-month lead time for advertising and Calendar listings. News items are reviewed daily.

How to File

E-mail your story to Brian McDonough at <mcdonough@cue.org> as a plain text attachment (or in the body of an e-mail). Add any auxiliary information at the bottom of the story file. Include your name at the top on any attachments, photos or supplementary materials.

Changes or Corrections

Authors are responsible for the accuracy and originality of their articles. If corrections need to be made after submission, please inform the editor in writing as soon as possible. Because of our publishing schedule we are not able to send authors copies of their edited articles for approval before publication. We reserve the right to edit any article submitted.

Rights & Payments

OnCUE buys First Time North American Rights, including the Web, and pays on acceptance. You must submit an invoice for payment.

Reprints

CUE occasionally grants permission to other publications to reprint articles. Please contact CUE to request reprint permission.
