1. Topic ***Attachment & Bonding***
Presenters Mary Cornett & Linda Maxwell-Mack, Henrietta Weill Memorial Child Guidance Clinic
Description A primary need of babies and human beings is to have an emotional, trusting and secure relationship. Learn how Attachment & Bonding impacts the infant/toddler's mental health.
2. Topic ***Finding Your Voice: Finger-plays, songs and movement for infants and toddlers***

Description Find your voice! The human voice is the most interesting thing to an infant. Sing, move and make the most out of spontaneous songs, finger-plays and movement with those precious little ones.
3. Topic ***Beyond Family Style Dining for Infants & Toddlers***
Presenter Debbie Bergstrom, Resources for Infant Educators (RIE)
Description A mealtime in childcare is more than "feeding children." It's a time for fostering self-help skills, independence, language, social skills and basic healthy nutrition. Creating a meaningful mealtime for infants/toddlers that will build on the skills needed to become a competent, self-reliant child. This workshop will focus on the details of the dining experience to ensure it is a respectful, peaceful and successful time for the infant/toddler and caregiver/educator.
4. Tema ***Nutrición para Infantes y Niños Menores***

Por ejemplo, el poder amamantar reduce el riesgo en el bebé de algunos tipos de infecciones y de enfermedad. También aumenta su oportunidad de obtener un peso más sano durante su vida. Adoptar un enfoque saludable en la nutrición y aumento de peso durante los primeros años del bebé. Insistir que los padres no deben poner a los bebés en dietas o restringir los alimentos ricos en nutrientes.

Description This workshop will provide an overview of infant and toddlers. It's never too early to set the stage for healthy eating habits. Even in infancy, feeding can have a lifetime impact on health and weight. For example, breast feeding can reduce a baby's risk of some types of infections and illness. It also increases their chances of a healthy weight later in life. Take a healthy approach to nutrition and weight gain during baby's first years. Adamant that parents should not put babies on diets or restrict nutrient rich foods.
