Most Compelling Service Outcome

Delano School Readiness Initiative is one of the 13 SRI programs and aims to enhance and provide integrated, multi-disciplinary services that support children ages zero to five and their families. Delano SRI offers home visitation, case management, referral services, parent education services, early childhood education services in a licensed facility, developmental assessment for children ages zero to five, provision of basic needs items, health insurance application assistance, and school readiness education within a licensed facility. The Wilcoxon Signed Ranks test provides data on the proportion of children who demonstrated improvement, had no change, or negative change from pre-test to post-test. Most children who were assessed showed improvement in motor, social-emotional, communication, self-help, and cognitive skills and the improved scores were statistically significant, which means there is a low probability that the change occurred by chance.

Benchmark/Baseline Data

To measure the number and percent of children who demonstrate improvement in school readiness skills, pre-test and post test scores from the Summer Bridge Assessment were compared using a Wilcoxon Signed Ranks test.

Outcome Measurement Tool

Each participating child is assessed (Summer Bridge Assessment) at the beginning (pre-test) and end (post-test) of the program to measure motor, social-emotional, communication, self-help, and cognitive skills.

One of the two programs within this Service Area is The Kern County Children's Dental Health Network which is a partnership program between West Kern Community College District and the Kern County Superintendent of Schools. The program provides mobile dental services to children at their school. Dental hygiene students from the Taft College Dental Hygiene Program provide an oral screening, oral health education, the assessment of plaque levels, application of fluoride and sealants to preschool and kindergarten children. All children received an initial plaque index to determine their percentage of plaque at first examination and 192 children were randomly selected to receive a follow-up plaque index screening. The mean plaque index score at intake was 64.2% and at follow-up the mean dropped to 35.3%. Of the 192 children rescreened, 84% demonstrated a decrease in plaque at follow-up.

Benchmark/Baseline Data

The starting plaque indexes are compared to the subsequent indexes to determine if there is a decline in dental plaque accumulation. The average plaque index at first examination was 64.2%.

Outcome Measurement Tool

Every tooth has four surfaces (mesial, distal, buccal and lingual) that are susceptible to plaque. The plaque index is a percentage and is calculated based on the number of tooth surfaces present and the number of tooth surfaces that have plaque.
