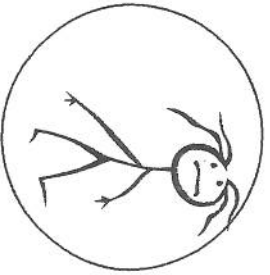


Parenting Styles

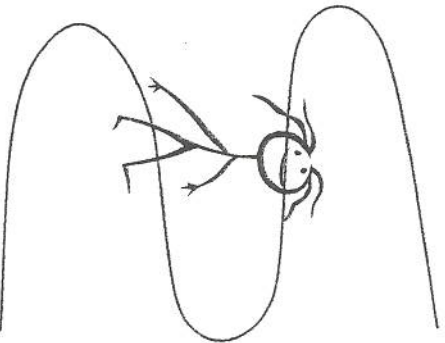
Too Strict



Limits Without Freedom

Children respond with fear, rebellion and frustration. Poor boundary development, low self worth, no self-discipline are common results of this parenting style.

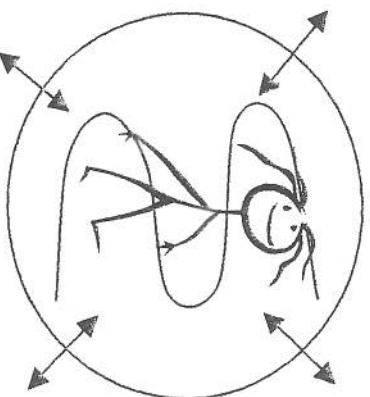
Permissive



Freedom Without Limits

Children are confused and insecure. Children have no point of reference for developing boundaries and self-discipline. Children understand that the parent doesn't care.

Flexible/Cooperative



Freedom With Limits

Increasingly responsible behavior as a result of expanding self-discipline. Child learns cooperation, while increasing self-esteem, and courage. Child feels secure.
