



Enabling Funds Information

General Information

1. Grant amounts for Enabling Funds vary from year to year.
2. An Enabling Fund is for **non-profit programs** that provide service to the community and is consistent with the purpose of the Junior League of Bakersfield (JLB). JLB's focus area is Women and Child Welfare, including issues related to at-risk, abused and neglected, health, and education.
3. An Enabling Fund may be granted **only once to an agency for the same purpose**.
4. An Enabling Fund may be used for a one-time purchase/rent of equipment.
5. An Enabling Fund is a one-year grant ranging from \$100 to \$2,000.

Procedures

1. Enabling Fund proposals must be submitted to the Junior League of Bakersfield office by **Thursday December 1, 2011 by 2:00pm or postmarked by December 1, 2011. No applications will be accepted after this date.**
2. Proposals are screened and evaluated by the JLB Community Research Committee and the Projects Evaluation Committee. Recommendations for expenditures are made to the Board of Directors and General Membership for a final vote of approval. Applicants will be notified of the results by June 1, 2011.
3. Each Enabling Fund recipient will sign a Letter of Agreement regarding the use of funds.
4. Enabling monies are awarded at the September 12, 2012 JLB General Meeting unless specified in the contract.
5. Recipients will submit periodic reports and an annual report to JLB upon final expenditure of funds to the PEC Chair.

Deadline is December 1, 2011 at 2:00pm or postmarked by December 1, 2011
