### **Who is Eligible?**

Parenting teens *18 years of age and younger* who are interested in earning their high school diplomas and are enrolled in one of the KCSOS Alternative Education Programs. Please call and find out if you can be eligible for enrollment at one of our school sites.

### **Cal-SAFE Blanton CDC Referrals and waiting list**

### **What do I need to do before I bring my child to the day care center?**

All students must attend an Orientation with the Cal SAFE Blanton Child Development Site Supervisor. The infant/toddler must have a recent physical and have an updated immunizations record before enrollment. Students are required to attend a parenting enrichment class offered by the Blanton CDC Cal-SAFE Program.
