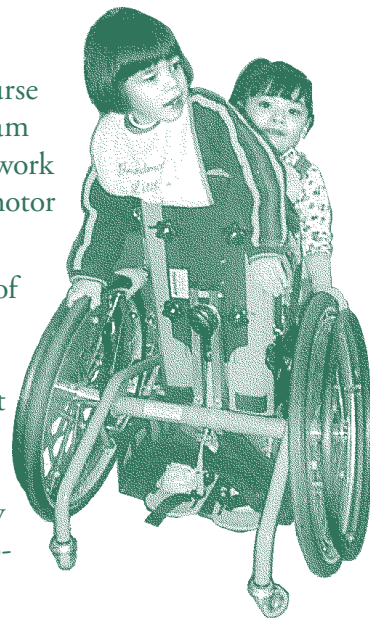

MOVE Basic Providers

June 23-24, 2010 Wednesday: 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
Two-Day Course Thursday: 8 a.m. To 4 p.m.

Basic Provider training is a two-day introductory course on the use of the MOVE Program and Curriculum for those who work with children and adults with motor disabilities.

Upon successful completion of this two-day training, attendees are certified as MOVE Basic Providers. There is no term limit on Basic Provider certification. Basic Providers, however, are not certified to teach and certify others on use of the MOVE Program and Curriculum.



Prerequisites: NONE

Course Objectives:

- ▲ Learning to determine eligibility for the MOVE Program
- ▲ Understanding the six steps of the MOVE Program and how to use the MOVE Curriculum and Assessment Profile
- ▲ Learning how to test and evaluate students/clients in order to design an individualized program for developing mobility skills for more active involvement and participation in the home and community
- ▲ Learning how to use equipment and common furniture as instructional tools

Prerequisites:

Completion of the MOVE Basic Provider course and at least one year of experience using the MOVE Program. Candidates must also have an undergraduate college degree in a field related to serving people with disabilities.

Course Description:

The primary focus of the course is to prepare MOVE International Trainers® to teach the MOVE Basic Provider Program.
