

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We hope your child is looking forward to an amazing week at the Kern Environmental Education Program. The KEEP staff is ready to deliver an environmental experience that your child will always remember.

***These forms must be completely filled out, signed and returned to your child's school:***

**1) Registration Form:**

Fill out completely and sign in all three places at the bottom. Attach copy of health insurance card.

**2) KEEP Pupil Medication Form: (when needed)**

Complete this form if your child needs to take any prescription or over-the-counter medications (examples of over-the-counter medications could include: Tylenol, Motrin or cough drops). For medication administration, California state law requires an up-to-date **KEEP Pupil Medication Form** with each medication signed by both the doctor and the parent. No medications will be given if this form is not completed with the required signatures. Conditions not controlled by medication may prevent your child from attending. The KEEP campuses are an hour away from a health care facility. Your child's health and safety are a vital concern.

**3) Physician's Authorization to Attend Form: (when needed)**

Student with specialized health care conditions may not attend KEEP without this completed form and KEEP Director approval. Please contact Director Tom Anspach (661-871-1883) and notify your child's teacher immediately if any of the following serious medical conditions apply: 1) Any medications requiring injections (i.e. Epipen or Glucagon), 2) Diabetes, 3) Severe bee sting or insect bite reaction, 4) Severe food or nut allergy reaction, 5) Mobility limitations, 6) Severe asthma (i.e. requiring nebulizer or activity restrictions), 7) Seizure Disorder, 8) Respiratory Restrictions (i.e. respiratory conditions limiting activity), 9) Recent hospitalization or 10) Other serious health conditions.

If your child has a serious medical condition, permission to participate will be determined on an individual basis.

Your careful attention in providing accurate information will help us give your child the best and safest week possible.
