What to Bring to KEEP Cambria & KEEP Ocean

| 2 or 3 pairs of shoes (tennis shoes or hiking boots; no sandals) | 1 flashlight (KEEP Ocean only) |
| 8 pairs of long socks (no ankle socks) | 1 toilet kit to include: |
| 4 pairs of pants or sweats (no shorts) | - comb and/or brush |
| 1 warm jacket | - 1 bath towel and wash cloth |
| 1 or 2 sweaters or sweat shirts | - shampoo/conditioner |
| 7 shirts or T-shirts | - toothbrush |
| 5 pairs of underwear | - toothpaste |
| 2 handkerchiefs or Kleenex | - chapstick |

Poncho or raincoat and extra dry shirts, pants and socks to change into.

Optional Items:

Camera & extra film (kids go through their first roll by Tuesday), binoculars, sun glasses, backpack, \$7 for an additional KEEP T-shirt, flip-flops or sandals for shower, earplugs if you are a light sleeper and a watch or alarm clock.
