As educators you know the value of introducing youths to the natural world. Tucker Wildlife Sanctuary's rural Orange County location offers K-12 teachers an exciting way to ignite the interest of their students in the environment. Hikes and activities provide cross-curricular lessons in science, art and culture, and language arts. Each tour lasts approximately two hours. Typical tour topics include: Our Native Habitats, Flora and Fauna of the Santa Ana Mountains, Native American Uses of the Natural Resources, and Nature Observations. Program Fees are only \$6 per student.

We realize that the cost of Program Fees and busing combined may be unaffordable to many classes. Tucker Wildlife Sanctuary, with the generous support of SCWRP, is making a limited amount of funding available to assist with busing costs for school field trips to Tucker. **Applicants must have 50% of students enrolled in free and reduced price lunch program.**

Due to the high cost of busing, we request that classes combine for field trips. Tucker will fund 100% of the busing costs for 60 or more students per bus or Special ED classes. Partial funding available for smaller groups.
