THE KERN COUNTY TRUANCY REDUCTION PROGRAM SUMMARY OF FINDINGS FOR THE 1998-1999 SCHOOL YEAR

The Kern County Truancy Reduction Program (TRP) is a multi-faceted program funded through the Kern County Substance Abuse Prevention Education Consortium. The primary goal of the TRP is to improve school attendance among TRP referred students who have four or more unexcused absences and / or incidents of arriving to class late (30 minutes or more). Other related goals include increasing academic performance and improving social functioning among students.

Attached are a number of tables showing summary results from data collected at TRP participating schools during the 1998-99 school year. While more detailed information by school is available upon request, highlights of the TRP program for the 98-99 school year were as follows:

- Despite a total of 364 students participating in TRP during the 1998-99 school year, only 149 students or 41 percent met the TRP referral criteria of 4 or more unexcused absences (Summary Tables 8 and 9).¹
- These 149 students had a combined total of 2,591 unexcused absences during the entire 98-99 school year, for an average of 17.4 unexcused absences per student (Summary Table 8).
- Nearly one-quarter (22.1%) of TRP students in 98-99 had zero unexcused absences after TRP intervention and, almost half (48.3%) of the TRP students had less than four unexcused absences after TRP intervention (Summary Table 4).
- The number of students in TRP in 98-99 remains less than one percent of the total student population of the participating school districts (Summary Table 8).
- While there were a total of 25 districts that referred 364 students to TRP during the 98-99 school year, only 19 districts had a combined total of 149 students that met the TRP referral criteria of 4 or more unexcused absences (Summary Tables 8 and 9).
- Fifth grade TRP students had the highest number of law violation cases (PC272—Willful Neglect) with 4 reported for any grade. Whereas, second and third grade TRP students had the highest proportion of successfully completing the program with a combined total of 8 cases (Summary Table 12).

¹ TRP officers will, at the request of a Principal, work with students who have excessive excused absences to determine if there is a serious medical problem, a potential Child Protective Services issue, or a possibility for setting up a child on a home study program.

Overall the characteristics of TRP students for the 1998-99 school year are somewhat different from those served in previous years. Highlights of the TRP data over the past five years is as follows:

- A look at the data by grade shows that the percent of junior high students participating in the program increased from 6.6 percent in 97-98 to 11.4 percent in 98-99 for seventh grade students and from 11.3 percent in 97-98 to 12.1 percent in 98-99 for eighth grade students. During the same period, there continued to be an increase in the percent of first and second grade students from 10.0 percent and 9.0 percent in 96-97 to 12.1 percent and 18.1 percent in 98-99 (Summary Table 15).
- The percent of total unexcused absences (absences tracked during participation in TRP) by grade increased for seventh and eighth grade students from 6.3 percent in 97-98 to 12.5 percent in 98-99 and from 12.3 percent in 97-98 to 19.0 percent respectively. With the exception of the 97-98 school year, seventh and eighth grade students account for the largest proportion of unexcused absences from 1993 to 1997 and 1998-1999 (Summary Table 17).
- While the percent of TRP students by gender reflects that female students have outnumbered their male counterparts for all six years of the TRP, the percentages are the closest that they have ever been with 50.6 percent female and 49.4 percent male. The percent of TRP unexcused absences for females has continued to decrease from 63.8 percent in 1996-97 to 50.6 percent in 1998-99 (Summary Tables 18 and 21).
- For the first time since the 1993-94 school year, the percentage of students in TRP compared to overall enrollment has increased from .5 percent in 97-98 to .6 percent in 98-99. However, the average number of unexcused absences per student continues to steadily increase from 9.1 in 93-94 to 17.4 in 98-99 (Summary Tables 8 and 22).

Monthly Summary Data

Active Referrals

The number of active referrals is calculated by adding the number of new referrals to the accumulated caseload of an officer and then subtracting the number of released cases. Overall, TRP officers recorded 1,666 Active Referrals during the 98-99 school year. Of these referrals the Richland-Lerdo School District represented the highest proportion among districts with 16.2 percent or 269 active referrals (Monthly Tables 1 and 2).

- Officers reported a total of 125 home visits, 890 school visits, 473 staff contacts, 476 student contacts, and 687 parent/guardian contacts by either phone or letter, for a combined total of 2,651 officer contacts for the 98-99 school year (Monthly Table 3).
- *CPS Filed/Recommended*
During the 98-99 school year, TRP officers either filed or recommended a total of 16 cases to Child Protection Services (CPS). The Beardsley, Richland-Lerdo, and Rio Bravo-Greeley Union school districts ranked first within this category with four cases each (Monthly Tables 9 and 10).
- *Support Agency Referral*
TRP officers referred eight cases to support agencies during the 98-99 school year. The Richland-Lerdo school district accounted for the highest number reported with four cases (Monthly Tables 9 and 11).
- *Presentations*
Officers did not make any presentations to districts during the 98-99 school year (Monthly Tables 9).
- *Referral to District Attorney (DA)*
The District Attorney received a total of 20 referrals from TRP officers during the 98-99 school year. Richland-Lerdo comprised 45 percent of the total referrals to the DA (Monthly Tables 9 and 12).
- *Officer Statistics*
TRP Officer Murphy reported 75 percent of the cases that were referred to the district attorney's office. Of the 16 cases recommended or filed for Child Protective Services (CPS), 15 of the cases or 94 percent were also recommended by Officer Murphy.
