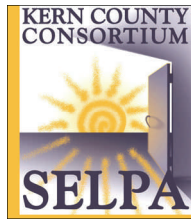

*“Priority registration will be given to employees of Kern County Consortium SELPA member districts. Your registration will be confirmed by e-mail 1 week prior to the event.”*

Participants will receive a full day of training in powerful strategies for eliciting good behavior from all students and providing effective responses to students who present as challenging and disruptive, followed by two days of physical crisis response training. Some of the training involves vigorous physical activity—therefore, participants must be physically fit. Districts are required to enroll site-based teams only, with a minimum of at least three people per site. Certified personnel are required to recertify **annually**. In order to certify, participants must attend all 3 days.

- Cost: \$65 per participant for all three (3) days of training. **PO must be submitted with registrations form.** Fee is nontransferable & nonrefundable
- Materials will be provided during the training.
- Please wear loose, comfortable clothing like jeans or jogging suits, tennis shoes. No jewelry or long nails.
- Some of the training involves physical activity; participant must be physically fit.
- You will be on your own for lunch.
- Minimum teams of at least 3 people per school site.
